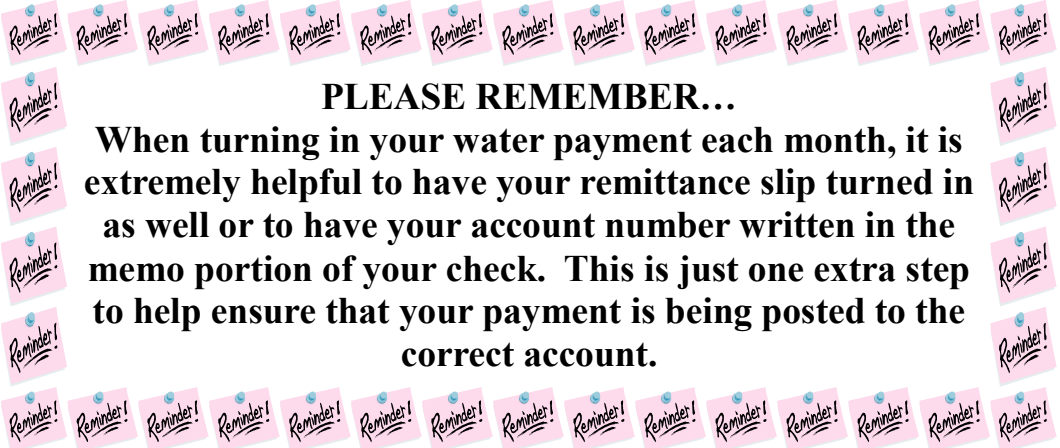

From the Archives

- 1861- David Simpson became postmaster.
- 1862- Philemon Morris became postmaster.
- 1863- Sublimity elementary school officially became District No. 7, with 110 students.
- 1866- John W. Cusick became postmaster
- 1866- J. R. Sellwood, a graduate of Willamette University, assumed presidency of the college. He later became a prominent Portland businessman - the Sellwood district bears his name. The fourth and last president of Sublimity college was Prof. John W. Garrison. Through his efforts the enrollment reached 125 by the end of the 1860s. "We taught a little of everything." Local students lived at home; others boarded at the school or with local residents. However the withdrawal of the United Brethren church and the depression following the Civil War hastened its closure. Too, both the public school district, which itself had decreased to 50 students, and the college taught some of the same subjects and both depended on the available public money.
