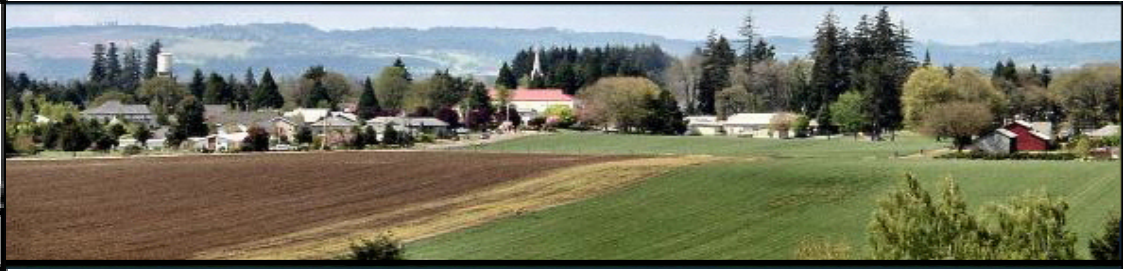

DEPUTY'S CORNER

Well, I have been here for about a month now and would like to thank you all for welcoming me. I have met a lot of you by you merely stopping by, or walking up to say hello when you see me around town. This is not the greeting we get in some places, trust me, your city is terrific.

I would like to talk about your speed zones here in town. I have noticed, as I know most of you probably have, that some of them are posted at speeds that seem to be on the high side considering what is around them. It's important to note that a posted speed zone begins at that sign, not when you can see it. For example, Starr Street NW leaving town toward Salem is 30 mph, but traveling westbound there is not a sign advising of that, there is a 45 mph sign visible as you head up the hill, but 45 mph begins at that sign. Church Street is a 25 mph zone until after you travel through the s-curves to the east, where it then becomes a 55 mph zone. Some of you may have noticed a radar trailer in town here and there. This trailer does many things other than just showing the speed at which you are traveling. It counts vehicles, produces charts of average speeds, can tell you what speeds are traveled and at what time of day those were - and no, it does not take your picture. My goal is to hopefully utilize some of this information in the future to continue the excellent working relationship we have with our County Public Works Department and perhaps one day improve the signage issue with some of the zones here in town.

So until next time, Drive Safely and be Good Neighbors. Thanks for having us here. And don't forget National Night Out on August 2nd at Early Settlers Park—hope to see you there!
