## **Reminder about Water/Sewer Billing Changes**

**Effective July 1, 2009, water and sewer rates will be increasing for residents and businesses within the city limits. Here are a few highlighted changes: A 7.5% increase will be in effect for sewer rates - this is due to our contracted rate with the City of Stayton increasing by 7.5%. Water base rates will be increasing from \$5 to \$7 for residential customers and water usage rates will also be slightly increased depending on gallons used.**

**Commercial base rates will vary depending on meter size.**

**Shut-off/delinquent account fees will be increasing from \$10 to \$25 and NSF fees will now be \$25. Rental deposit fees will be increasing from \$50 to \$75 - only \$50 of this deposit fee will be refundable. Changes have been made to the water/sewer waiver process as well. If you would like a copy of Ordinance 711 which outlines the new fees and changes, please feel free to contact city hall during normal business hours.**

## **Weeds & Tall Grass**

A reminder that weeds and trees on your property are your responsibility to maintain. Trees and bushes cannot hang lower than 10 feet on the roadway and 8 feet on a sidewalk. Weeds must not exceed 10 inches in height. Any property that is found to have overgrown trees/bushes or weeds will be in violation of Ordinance 709.
