HOME ALARMS

The city is currently reviewing our alarm ordinance procedures and will be sending out letters to homeowners regarding their current alarm permits. As a reminder **ALL HOMES WITH MONITORED ALARMS MUST HAVE AN ALARM PERMIT.**

The city will be mailing out letters to current alarm permit holders—if your alarm system is currently **UNREGISTERED**, please contact city hall during normal business hours for registration assistance.

Registration Deadline is August 1, 2011

BACKFLOW DEVICES

A reminder that backflow devices were to be tested by **June 30th**. The city will be sending letters to homeowners who have not had their backflow devices inspected. Per Oregon Statute, violators can be fined up to \$500 for non-compliance.
