
## **IT'S ELECTION TIME!**

## **Frequently asked Questions at City Hall**

**Building a fence?** Please make sure you contact City Hall for a permit. Although there is no fee to build a fence, the city does have codes that need to be followed and they require approval.

**Building a storage shed?** Sheds under 200sq feet do not require a permit. If you are building anything bigger you must get a structural permit from the city and follow city codes.

**Can we have Chickens?** Yes they are allowed. NO ROOSTERS! Although there are codes to follow as to the placement of a chicken coop. As always, please be respectful to your neighbors!

**Does the city allow vehicles parked on the street?** We have a code for that! Vehicles must be legally licensed and not parked in one spot for more than three days. The street is not a storage space. Vehicles should be parked on your own property. Recreational vehicles like boats and Rv's/campers are not allowed to be parked on the street.
