

NOTICE OF PLANNING COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING LEGISLATIVE AMENDMENTS TO THE SUBLIMITY DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 227.186 requires this notice contain the following statement in boldfaced type across the top of the face page extending from the left margin to the right margin.

The City of Sublimity has proposed amendments to the Sublimity Development Code that may affect the permissible uses of your property and other properties.

ORS 227.186 also requires this notice to state: The City has determined that adoption of the amendments may affect the permissible uses of your property, and other properties in the affected zone, and may change the value of your property.

For example, the proposed amendments add churches and mobile food vendors as permitted uses in the Commercial – General District.

This notice is provided because you own property or a business or live in the Sublimity city limits.

No property will be rezoned by the proposed amendments to the Development Ordinance.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Monday, August 29, 2022, at 6:00 pm, the Sublimity Planning Commission will conduct an in-person and virtual (Zoom) public hearing regarding proposed amendments to the Sublimity Development Ordinance (case number LA 2021-01).

A copy of the 62-page staff report to the Planning Commission is available for inspection at City Hall located at 245 NW Johnson Street or may be purchased at a reasonable cost.

Any person desiring to speak either for or against the proposed amendments may do so in person or by authorized representative at the public hearing. Prior to the hearing written comments may be submitted by mail to P.O Box 146, Sublimity, OR 97385, or via email to Myrna.Harding@CityofSublimity.org, or dropped off at City Hall at 245 NW Johnson Street.

At the conclusion of the public hearing, the Planning Commission will make a recommendation to the Sublimity City Council regarding the proposed amendments. The City Council is the decision authority and will conduct a second public hearing at a date to be determined. A notice of the City Council hearing will be included in a future water bill mailing.

There are many "housekeeping" changes and several substantive changes related to (1) change churches from a Conditional Use to a Permitted Use in the Commercial-General District, update the lot line adjustment criteria to be consistent with State law, (3) consolidate the nonconforming standards into Section 3.109, Nonconforming Uses, (4) add the clear and objective duplex standards in the R-2 District to the duplex standards in the R-1 District, (5) add support structure standards for HAM antennas and that HAM operators be certified, (6) add mobile food vendors as a Permitted use in the General-Commercial District, subject to standards, (7) allow flag lots in subdivisions, (8) update the drive-up window standards, (9) increase the types of applications required to have a pre-application meeting.

Frequently asked Questions at City Hall

Along with City Ordinance, you should always check with your CCR's before building accessory structures or parking a recreational vehicle in your driveway. CCR's take precedence over the City Ordinances.

<u>Backflow Devices:</u> Backflow devices must be tested annually. A list of backflow inspectors can be found on the City website or at City Hall.

<u>Building a fence</u>? Please make sure you contact City Hall for a permit. Although there is no fee to build a fence, the city does have codes that need to be followed and they require approval.

Building a storage shed? Sheds under 200sq feet do not require a permit. If you are

building anything bigger you must get a structural permit from the city and follow city codes.

<u>Parking on Street:</u> NO Parking of Cargo Trailers, RVs, Boats or any vehicle of any type is allowed on the street for more than 72 hours.

Garage Sales: You are required to obtain a \$5.00 permit from City Hall before having a garage sale.
