Park Donations

The City of Sublimity welcomes gifts, memorials, and donations as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit. You can donate to the City of Sublimity and leave a legacy for the benefit of future generations. All gifts are tax deductible and allow for the designation of donations to a certain department or for the use in a specific park.

Donations can be made in honor of a person or group.

Cash donations not specified to a specific department or park will be placed in the Parks donation fund to be allocated through the budget process.

Frequently asked Questions at City Hall

Along with City Ordinance, you should always check with your CCR's before building accessory structures or parking a recreational vehicle in your driveway. CCR's take precedence over the City Ordinances.

Lost and Found: City Hall has a lost and found. If you have lost something in one of the City parks, be sure to check with City Hall to see if it has been turned in. If you find that someone has left a belonging behind, you can turn it in to City Hall.

Garage Sales: You are required to obtain a \$5.00 permit from City Hall before having a garage sale.

Pets: Pets are required to be kept on leash at all times while in city parks. Pet owners are required to clean up after their animals. Mutt Mitts are available in the parks.

Building permits: All structural Permits for shops, additions, new homes or ADU's must be submitted at City Hall.

Garbage Cans: Please keep garbage cans behind the front of the house. No garbage cans should be left in the road for more than 24 hours.

TYPE A PERMIT: A Permit is required for projects that include: Fence/ Deck or Patio / Irrigation System/ Landscaping / Signs / Shed or Accessory buildings. The Type A Permit is available online at www.cityofsublimity.org under Resources / Forms & Permits or at City Hall. This is a no charge permit process.
